Guidelines

- Available on **first-come, first-served** basis to anyone with a valid Connecticut library card
- **2-day** checkout period
- **Limit of one (1)** pass per day, per family
- **Return to lending desk**, not in book drop or at another library
- **\$10/day overdue fine**, up to \$100 maximum
- **\$100.00 for lost pass**

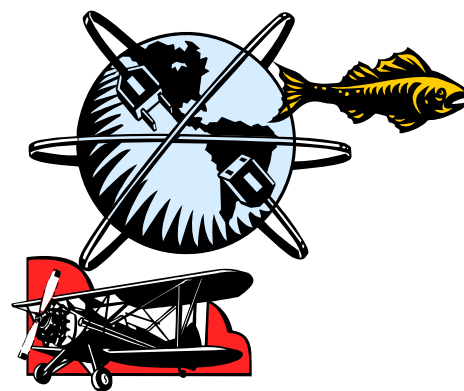
